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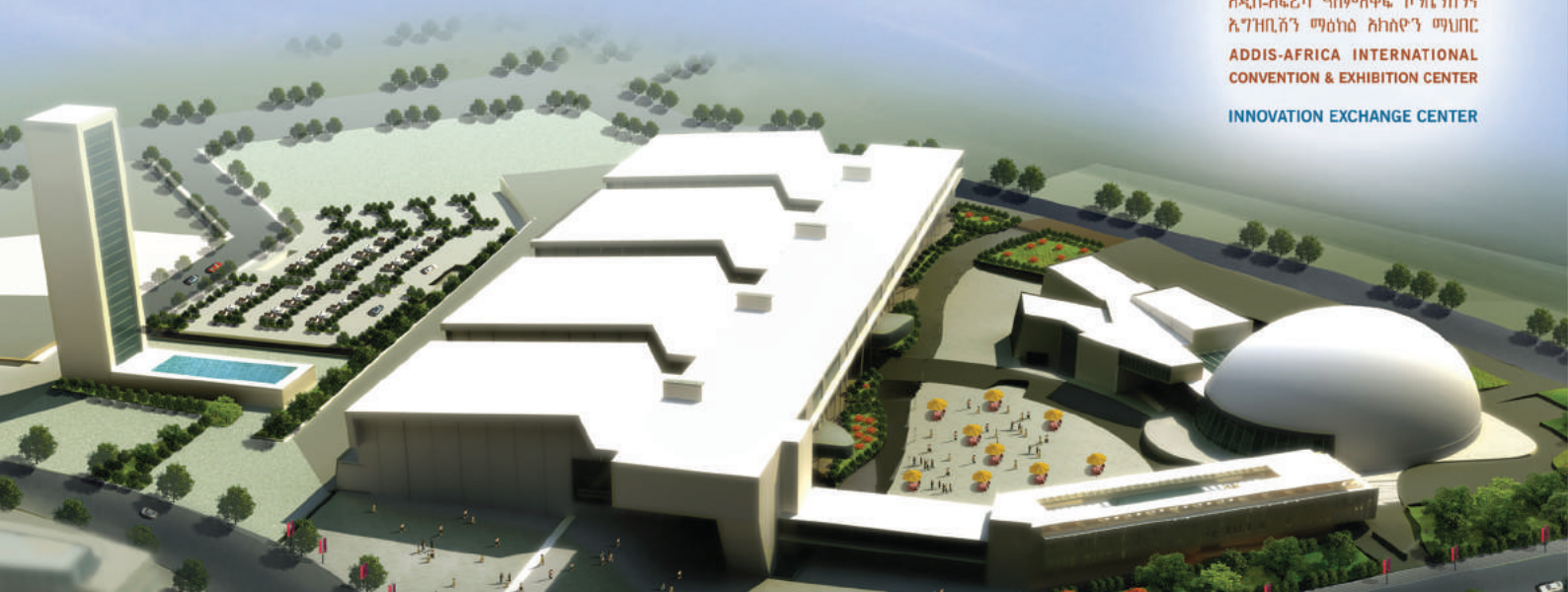

A WEEK IN

Welcome to Addis Ababa, a city of like no other, flourishing on the roof of Africa! This year's edition of the city's Hotel Association guide to Addis hospitality is aimed at giving you, our honored visitor, an all-round perspective of our unique city. We invite you to take time to immerse yourself in the captivating history, culture, tradition, and day-to-day life of Africa's capital. To begin this journey, let us find out what exactly is, Addis Ababa?

Addis Ababa, the metropolitan capital of Ethiopia is a city of eclectic architecture reflecting the influences of distinct periods in its 120 year-old history. The brief but notable productivity of the Italians during the occupation, the far sightedness of the former Emperor Haile Selassie who brought in foreign experts to help build the economy, and modern day developers who are reshaping the city's skyline, provide Addis with a unique allure. Today, the city houses more than one hundred and twenty international missions and embassies, the headquarters of the African Union and the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa. It is aptly named 'the political capital of Africa'. As hotels rise and rise across the skyline, and as global airlines line up on the runway at Bole International Airport, one is reminded of the central role that the city plays in continental diplomacy and development, and Africa and the world.

Addis, as the city is affectionately known with a slight sharpening of the 'i', is an urban landscape of raw, unbridled, and intense, energy and vigor. It is the highest urban metropolis in Africa, sitting 2,355 meters above sea level. The city derives its name from the Meskel Flower that covers the fields of the Ethiopian highlands during the month of Meskerem (September). Flanked on three sides by mountains - Entoto to the north, Wochecha to the west, and Yerer to the east - the area became home to Menilek emperor of Ethiopia, and Taitu his empress, in the late 1800s.

Haile Selassie was driven in his determination to modernize his country and started with Addis Ababa. The University College of Addis Ababa was founded in 1950 (renamed the Haile Selassie I University in 1961, and Addis Ababa University after the revolution of 1974) in Arat Kilo. Several cultural institutions

were established – notably the impressive Haile Selassie Theatre in 1955, now the National Theatre, complete with a massive stone Lion of Judah sculpture (topped, significantly, with an imperial crown) outside the main entrance. Imposing high rise buildings were designed and often constructed by Greek and Armenian builders and architects, giving the city a cosmopolitan air.

This heady period in the city’s history was variously known as the ‘Addis spring’ and the ‘golden years’, as intense artistic creative activity took place, and there was a burgeoning of art and music, art galleries, and theatre, supported by the emerging bourgeoisie.

The era of the Derg, Ethiopia’s Marxist ruling junta brought the cultural surge to an end and the city saw the building of functional purpose-built blocks of flats to house the masses, many of whom had come flooding to the city in the wake of the famines of 1973 and 1984. The urban landscape, beyond accommodating these blocks, remained unchanged during this period and it was only following the overthrow of the Derg in 1991, that city planners began to reimagine and reshape Addis. The results are clear for all to see, today: the cityscape from whichever orientation, is a riot of multi storey concrete giants rising in various states of completion. To add to the construction melée, kilometers of yellow and green corrugated iron encloses areas of the city and conceals land that has been opened up, as old homesteads and communities are relocated to make way for urban reconstruction.

Ninety buildings across the city however have been identified as historical heritage sites. In time, these ‘memory capsules’ of a city will be renovated and returned to their former elegance. The turbulent, elegant, inimitable, spectacular rise of Addis Ababa, the city beneath the mountains, will be honored and celebrated.

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Starting the Day

Tomoca Piassa - Cathedral

There can be no better way to get ideas sharpened about a day in the city than at Tomoca, the home of modern coffee roasting in Ethiopia. The venerable establishment - it is the oldest coffee roasting business in Ethiopia - opened its doors in 1953. The company name is an abbreviation of 'torrefazione moderna café', or the 'modern coffee roasting café'. Tomoca is a family run business and the coffee is fully Arabica from Harrar, Yirgachefee and Sidamo - the three-top coffee producing regions of Ethiopia. The magic, however, is in the blend, and this is kept a closely guarded secret.

Drinking coffee at Tomoca is an experience that rises high above the branded coffee shops of the West. The establishment's pedigree - that it was the first company to roast and grind Ethiopian coffee for Ethiopians - means that all serious coffee drinking visitors to the city should pay homage at its counters in Wavell Street, Arada-Piassa. One may sample traditional espresso, macchiato, café latte and cappuccino while standing at high tables, soaking up the atmosphere of early morning Addis. Such is the fame of Tomoca that additional branches are springing up around the city. However, as a start to the day, the experience and ambience of Addis's original coffee house (whose décor has hardly changed since it opened decades ago) is something of an experience.

Café Choche La Gare

Café Choche is not far from the town center, down Churchill Avenue. The café is a delightful off-the-beaten track coffee establishment in a small garden, next to one of the architectural gems of Addis Ababa, La Gare. La Gare (The Station) marks the end of the Djibouti-Addis Ababa railway that was officially opened in 1929. The dream of the emperor, Menelik II, was to unify and modernize his people, and to forge a way to the sea. The railway line was instrumental to achieving this dream. Menelik's trusted advisor Swiss-born Alfred Ilg, was central to the project in its early days. From start to finish, the completion of the babore (railway) took thirty-five years, and Menelik was long gone when Haile Selassie, amidst great pomp and ceremony, opened La Gare, for business.

Moyos Café Atlas

Opposite the Yoly Addis Hotel in the Mickey Leland/EU street area Moyos Café is easily recognizable with its signature lime green coloring both inside and out. Moyos serves light meals throughout the day, but is a particularly favorite breakfast destination. On the menu are waffles and pancakes (served with Nutella or Maple Syrup), french toast, omelets, fresh seasonal fruits and one of the best versions of the Ethiopian/Sudanese specialty Special Foul - beans served with scrambled eggs, yogurt, and fresh tomatoes, accompanied by bread. Other dishes include sandwiches, burgers and salads and several vegetarian options. There is also a range of coffee variations and organic herbal teas to choose from, as well as a delicious selection of seasonal fresh juice combinations - carrots, beetroot, cucumbers, dates, bananas.....





Religion & Culture

A characteristic site in the city on any day of the week, is the gathering of the faithful, men and women in elegantly styled white woven garments and shama (shawls), about the city's many churches. The Ethiopian tradition of celebrating saints and holy days happens continuously and publicly throughout the year bringing out the city's residents in their numbers. These daily practices across the city signal the centrality of the Ethiopian Orthodox Tewahido Church, otherwise referred to as EOTC, in the life of its laity.

The Church in the life of Ethiopian Orthodoxy

Going to church is not limited to Saturday & Sunday mass and religious ceremonies. Owing to the syncretic nature

of the EOTC tradition and creed – there are many denominations with varying practices – all days of the month are filled with activity: Commemoration of angels, patron saints, martyrs, prophets, and apostles, in addition to the Holy Trinity, God, and the Virgin Mary. An ordinary believer attends church for at least fifteen days a month, once a day. The frequency and commitment to attend has thus multidimensional utilities and implications for the faithful. Such is the deep faith of Orthodox believers, that often, misfortune is identified as a function of disregarding religious obligations and infrequent church attendance.

The omnipresence of angels, patron saints, martyrs, prophets and apostles in the economic, social, and spiritual health of Ethiopian society is a feature that underlies the lives of Orthodox believers. In every family, at least two patron saints are commemorated monthly as well as the mandatory celebration of the day of God, the Trinity, the Virgin Mary, Archangel Mikael and Gabriel, Saint George, and recently, the popular patron saint, Arsema. Commemoration involves church attendance as well as activities in the home. In church, Ethiopian Orthodox members ask for their sins to be absolved, they beseech mercy and good fortune, they pray for a successful marriage, and for fertility.

Even matters of employment, health, betrothal, pregnancy, and birth, are matters for believers to request divine intervention by mediation of angels, patron saints, martyrs, prophets and apostles. This reverence for the greater celestial company is considered tantamount to the expression of reverence and devotion to God.

Acknowledging the poor and the needy, and doing charity in the name of the company of saints and angels is considered a high religious virtue. Chronicles of patron saints, martyrs, prophets, and apostles, and readings from religious books during mass, remind the laity that meeting religious obligation brings about cross-generational blessings and mercy for seven generations of a family.

Therefore, for both religious and secular reasons, regular church attendance is not only about the current generation, but about the generations to come, and about the commemoration of those departed. The elderly faithful, by strictly adhering to church calendars, in effect determine the fate of their children, grandchildren and descendants down the generations. In recent times, the church has provided commercial opportunities where religious and secular items are sold. Large markets spring up around the church. Despite church tradition disapproving of commerce near church property, a blind eye is cast.

Among the religious commodities displayed in markets around churches, are those articles used for liturgy, mass, and other religious processions. These will include candles, incense, umbrellas, crosses, prayer books, vestments, beads, holy images and icons. Buying and offering these items to the church and to the priests have different meanings: Offering a candle as a source of light during the night-long prayers symbolizes the absolute purity and stainlessness of the body of Christ, the nourishment of life and the penetration and negation of darkness and thus, of evil. Offering incense, sweet fragrant smoke, will promote a

divine atmosphere with the delicious fragrance penetrating the building, symbolizing the purity of God and the church. Using incense follows a Jewish tradition dating back to the first temple of Solomon. The EOTC claims strong connection and descent from the temple. The use of incense during mass, burial, absolution, obsequies, and commemoration of the dead, sanctifies the ceremony. Offering a cross is the most important gift of all. The cross represents identification with the pain and suffering of Christ at Calvary. There are three types of crosses sold at church markets - those to be held by the priest, those to be offered for the church service and those worn by believers as a mark and article of their faith. Black neck strings are sold separately and when worn around the neck are a sign of Christian faith. Small crosses that are produced in monasteries and holy places are presumed blessed by holy fathers and are more valuable. Believers particularly look for small crosses crafted in the significant religious centers of Axum, Lalibela, and Debrelibanos, to offer to friends and family members. The small crosses and holy amulets are believed to offer protection from evil spirits and ill fortune.

Vestments worn by priests and deacons during church functions and high mass are also sold in the markets, together with the highly coloured, embroidered, umbrellas. Believers will buy vestments and umbrellas as offerings to the church to ease the way towards fulfillment of their wishes, and to glorify God. The markets are also where one may purchase holy pictures and icons, both for the home, the church and the wallet. Beyond religious items, believers are also able to procure necessary traditional consumables for their home in the church market. They can obtain green grass to cover the floor, and papyrus and reeds to embellish their home, adding an atmosphere of festivity and celebration on high and holy days.

The open church market can be said to draw the believer nearer to the religious centre, and as such, promotes a sense of religious solidarity, and identity.

When visiting the many beautiful churches of Addis Ababa, one becomes aware of people prostrating and crossing themselves as they pass through or near the grounds. In the EOTC tradition, prostration before a church, or in the direction of far-off monasteries and holy places, is commended and expresses obedience to the church creed. Accordingly, it is common to find even the most secular traveller making a sign of the cross and bowing a head towards seen or unseen religious centres. For so many people, the very odor of aromatic incense, the silence, the colorful processions, along with the gathering of the faithful in snow white clothes, offers a sense of belonging to a secured spiritual community. Getting to the safe haven of the church, in the midst of busy and bustling city life, reminds the believer that there is a place of tranquillity to retreat to.

These few aspects provide a sense of the importance of church in the life of Orthodox Ethiopian society. For an EOTC adherent, the church undergirds the totality of their way-of-being in the world, their being and their becoming.

Holy Trinity Cathedral in Arat Kilo

The cathedral's origins lie in the mid-19th century when it is said that the sacred stabot (ark), brought down from the highlands of Wollo, was placed in a small chapel where it rested until Emperor Menilek had a church built in a traditional style next door to his Adis ghebbi (palace). The earliest gabaz (administrator of church landholdings and other property) were Menilek's daughter Zewditu, and the niece, and wife, of Ras Teferi/Haile Selassie, Yeshashworq, and Menen, respectively. In 1924, Haile Selassie laid the cornerstone of the new Manebere Tsaba'ot Qedest Selassie that, unusual for its time, would be built in a baroque style. The architecture of the cathedral is utterly different to most Ethiopian churches built in traditional style, and is adorned by statues of angels and saints. The plan for the church was that it would be the resting place for deceased members of the royal family, civil, and military dignitaries, and renowned patriots. Not only is the church itself worthwhile visiting, (Haile Selassie and his wife Menen's mausoleums are contained within),

but also the cemetery, where the graves of those who shaped modern Ethiopia, politically, musically, and artistically can be viewed. Look out for the late Prime Minister of Ethiopia Meles Zenawi, daughter of famous suffragette Emily, Sylvia Pankhurst and her son Richard, artist Afewerke Tekle, one of Addis's early mayors, Kentiba Wossene Zamanel, a nationally loved musical artist Tilahun Gessesse and Blatengetta Lorenzo Ta'ezaz who accompanied Haile Selassie into exile during the occupation.

There were ecclesiastical artists who worked on the elaborate decoration of the church as well as a Greek artist who had made Addis his home. The construction of the church was interrupted by the Italian invasion in 1935, and it was completed after liberation in 1941. Next door to the cathedral, and in the compound, is the Haile Selassie Memorial Museum donated by Ato Kebede Tekalign, a benefactor and citizen of the city. The museum houses a large collection of royal items and artifacts.



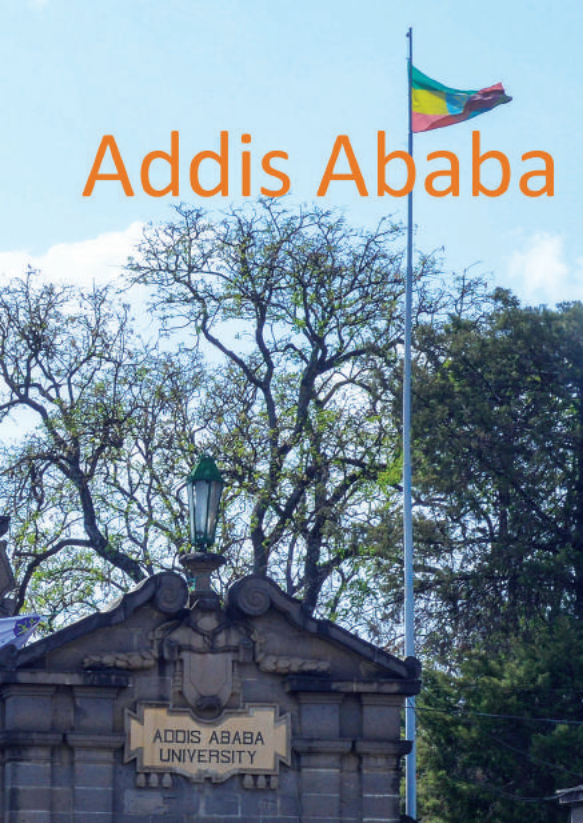
Entoto

Located high above the city lived Menelik and his wife, Taitu for many years. Their palace compound is blessed with a beautiful church, Manbare Tsahay Re'ese Adbarat Entoto Mariam commissioned by Taitu and her husband. The tabot (ark) of Entoto Mariam church with its beautiful canvas painted by Alaga Zayohannes, was brought from Gojjam after the defeat of King Tekle Haimanot of Gojjam by Menilek who at time was King of Shoa, at the Battle of Embabo in 1882. The tabot was housed in a small purpose-built thatched roof chapel in Entoto where it remained for over 30 years. The new church was extensively decorated both inside and out, and was inaugurated in 1914. Responsible for the original work

of decoration was Alaga Heruy Menbare, and over time, the church has been maintained by a series of devoted alagas who have preserved its original beauty. Empress Taitu was the first gabaz and she was later succeeded by Princess Yeshashworq Yelma, wife of a notable in Addis of the time. During the Italian aggression of Ethiopia, Entoto St. Mariam church was not heavily looted, but the golden crown of Emperor Menilek II, and a large cannon that had been captured by Menilek's army at the battle of Adwa in 1896, was taken by the occupying Italians. In the church compound, one will visit the palace, built in traditional style for the emperor and the empress, perching on the hilltop, high above the city. Its location provides a good viewing site of the city below. The palace contains an assembly room, banquet halls, and a reserve room for amenities. Located beside the church and the palace compound is the Menelik Museum, rich in imperial artifacts and ecclesiastical items that will give one a real sense of what was an important period of Ethiopia's history.

Addis Ababa

University & Museums



Addis Ababa University is in Sedist Kilo and here one can spend time at the museum of Ethnography, the National Museum, and the Modern Art Museum. The Museum of Ethnography is located inside the university's main campus and is housed in the former Genete-Le'ul, a former palace of Emperor Haile Selassie. It is the only museum of its type in the country exhibiting national history, tradition, and culture. The exhibitions include collections of ethno musicology, and Ethiopian stamp collections that provide a compelling visual snapshot of Ethiopian history; old coins, burial customs, and religious paintings. For added value, one can ask a museum official to provide a guided tour.

The National Museum is housed near the Museum of Ethnography is housed in a residence for the occupying Italian viceroy, Rodolfo Graziani. Following the defeat of Italy, the residence became the home of Prince Mekonen, son of Haile Selassie and Duke of Harar. By the 1960s, it had become the national museum, legally mandated to conserve the country's heritage and its historical value.

A key task of the museum is to control the illicit exports of relics. This particular task was mandated when it was

found that the country was being stripped of its historical and religious relics that were being sold on art markets around the world. Meandering through four separate exhibition halls, one can view paleontological, archeological, and historical items as well as ethnographic objects and artifacts. In the basement, the three and a half million-year-old Denqesh (Lucy) and other fossils, as well as stone tools, are conserved. The first floor is devoted to cultural heritage, historical and archaeological findings (organised under ancient, medieval, and contemporary), culture of the nation, and Ethiopian nationalities. The second floor houses an ethnography display where various collections of traditional and ceremonial costumes and related attire depict Ethiopia's cultural mosaic. The third-floor houses modern and contemporary art. Amongst the treasures on exhibition are works by Ethiopian master artist laureate, Afeworq Tekle. Afework, Ethiopia's national treasure has painted murals that can be viewed at the Economic Commission for Africa, African Hall, by arrangement, and at St Giorgis Cathedral. In the museum, one can view a collection of his critically acclaimed canvasses. Afework, who died in 2014, is buried in the Manebere Tsa'ba'ot Qedest Sellassie.

The Modern Art Museum named after Gebre Kristos Desta who lived from 1932 to 1981, is situated in the grounds of the university in the restored former palace of Alga Werash Asfaw Wosen, son of Haile Selassie. The lavish exteriors and interiors of the building are of architectural and historical importance in themselves. The building was re-purposed by Ethiopian architect, Fasil Giorghis. The museum provides a rich setting for collections that cover virtually every aspect of fine art. A note engraved on the front wall of the building reads: 'Addis Ababa University has devoted this museum to contribute to the intellectual and cultural life of Ethiopia as well as to host Gebre Kristos Desta's artistic achievements'. His art collection of some twenty-four works is permanently housed in four magnificent rooms of the Modern Art Museum. Also exhibited are the works of Gebre Kristos's contemporaries and disciples, Skunder Boghossian, Abdrhman Sherif, Yohannes Gedamu, Tibebe Tefffa, Behailu Bezabeh, Bekele Mekonen and Bisrat Shibabaw. A fitting tribute for an artist who is considered to be a touchstone for a generation of artists.



Merkato

Poet, Tsegaye Gabre-Medhin is believed to have written his popular poem entitled *Merkato* in 1972, upstairs, in the Mierab Hotel, near Merkato. 'Mercato' is Italian for 'marketplace' and is the name that was given by the Italians to one of Africa's largest open markets. It was founded in 1937 (European calendar) for the local population of Addis Ababa and was a manifestation of the occupiers' racial planning of the city. At the time of its creation, it was the only place where Ethiopians were permitted to trade and shop. The Italian occupiers who had invaded the country in 1935, forbade Ethiopians and other Africans from entering adjoining Piassa, a commercial area developed, and designated, for Europeans.

Merkato continues to thrive. It is a place of wondrous diversity and is made up of a myriad of different areas. For instance, areas such as Gojam Berenda*, Kibe Berenda, Abdo Berenda or Chid Tera, Berbere Tera, Minalesh Tera. In the 'Teras', places where categorised commodities are sold, one will find agricultural and manufactured goods sold in spite of fluctuations in temperature - scorching sun and freezing cold. Working side by side with the poor and the wretched, are the wealthy merchants as Merkato is equally the throbbing heart of Ethiopian commerce where wealth is stored in abundance.

Initially, Merkato was established on, and near, aristocratic landholdings - from the direction of Entoto (mountain) is the neighborhood of Ras Hailu; from the direction of Piassa, the bridge of Fitawrari Habta Giorgis is located. The old airport, alternatively known as Lideta locality was the land of Balcha Abanafeso and the land stretching up to Sebategna surrounding Merkato, to one other feudal lord, and so on. One might well argue that the opening of Merkato was a scheme designed to weaken the power of the landed aristocracy!

The social composition of Merkato is striking as it is a meeting place and melting pot of Ethiopian nations and nationalities. The business of Merkato carries the mark of different cultural and linguistic identities and localities. Some of the areas bear the name of different provinces, a case in point being Gojam, and Nekemt**, Berenda(s). People communicate in different languages and signs. The rich and the poor, the rural and urban, all have occupied their own corners and do business.

Everything and anything can be bought, even a single sock, in Minalesh Tera, and at any cost, from very low to very high cost. Merkato is for everyone.

In his poem, Tsegaye Gabre-Medhin has clearly shown life in Merkato in its entirety, but the work is layered, and close reading reflects this. Written on the eve of the popular Ethiopian revolution, the poetry carries sharp political criticism of the feudal emperor's inability to properly administer his country. Using Merkato as a metaphor, Tsegaye reveals the prevalence of poverty, crime, and the absence of strong, forward looking, leadership and administration. Moreover, in the disorder of Merkato, and with the level of insecurity suggested in the poetry, Tsegaye depicts the muffled sound of people devoid of expression.

Merkato the poem can thus be considered a prophetic work, revealing the wretched life of the people in the last years of feudal rule, crushed by oppression and exploitation. That the culmination of the popular revolution ushered in a period of bloodshed and utter misery under the military oligarchy, was not to be known at the time of composition.

St. George Gallery Arada-Piassa



The St George Gallery, up the hill from the Filwuha roundabout in Arada-Piassa, is a stylishly elegant establishment, a heavenly emporium for those with an eye for the aesthetic. Sisters Saba and Selam Alene are dedicated to promoting Ethiopian art and culture and together, curate collections of exquisite jewelry, woven cloth and house linen, furniture, paintings, and artifacts, sought out from artists and craftspeople across the land. The artisanal and artistic weavers, potters, woodworkers, sculptors, artists, furniture makers, and leather workers offer a feast for the eyes and it is quite possible to lose oneself for hours, and wander through the exhibition rooms, savoring the beauty of it all. The gallery, dating back to 1991, occupies an old Addis villa, set in a tranquil location. Saba and Selam's exquisite style and taste is clear for all to see.

Shiro Meda Shiro Meda



Shiro Meda is a bustling market at the northern edge of the city below Entoto Mountain. When the Emperor Menilek returned to Addis after his 'Southern March' when he subjugated the peoples of the south and brought them into his empire, he was accompanied by skilled artisans who settled in Shiro Meda. The descendants of these southern migrants continue to ply their trade in the same quarter today. The closely packed souks are the best place to shop for traditional Ethiopian cloth and clothing – scarves, shawls, traditional dresses, bed covers, and bed cushions, made primarily from traditional Ethiopian cotton known as shama, woven by a shamani or, weaver. Shiro Meda is also stocked with traditional souvenirs and crafts, including jewelry and basketware, and it is the preferred place to commission a tailor to make a made-to-measure dress. Prices are reasonable, and negotiation is welcomed.

Negist Ethiopia Old Airport

In Old Airport and nearby Mekanissa, the ancient craft of weaving and dying is taken up a notch in two galleries, where silk weave enters the respective collections. Old Airport is so named as it was once the location of the city's airfield. The aerodrome is long gone, only the name remains to remind one of times past. The first establishment is an elegantly appointed woven cloth boutique, Negist Ethiopia, near the International Community School. Named after the proprietor, the gallery offers contemporary craftsmanship whilst preserving the country's enduring history of weaving. The net result is an absorbing and bountiful experience. A range of hand woven items is on display, artisanally dyed and embroidered, something for everyone, gabis (highland blankets), traditional dresses, shama, shirts, robes, bed wear, and cushion covers. Local artisans, weavers, embroiderers, and seamstresses can be viewed at work in the workshop behind the gallery. Added to the collection are leather items and traditional household goods.

Sabahar Mekanissa

In Mekanissa, Sabahar, like Negist Ethiopia, preserves and celebrates the rich traditional weaving culture of Ethiopia. Cotton and silk cloth is on display, made up into exquisitely produced scarves, towels, table linens, cushions covers, and throws. The weaving workshop is found below the shop, and the garden that resembles an ancient romantic shrine, houses the rest of the team - spinners and dyers (and sometimes caterpillars). Sabahar is a member of the World Fair Trade Organisation and creates ethical and sustainable employment for marginalized members of society, with an emphasis on providing work for women. The cottons and silks are naturally sourced in Ethiopia, and Sabahar is credited as being one of the very few companies in the world producing textiles with Ethiopian silk. The dyes are entirely natural, created from local plants and herbs.

soleRebels SarBet

A short distance from the weave galleries in Mekanissa and Old Airport is a one-of-its-kind shoe shop. Ethiopia is well known for its leather, and there are many shoe shops throughout the city. However, soleRebels stands out. Describing itself as an artisan-run enterprise, it produces shoes made from recycled tyres and purpose-woven fabric and leather. The shoes are fun, funky, colorful, practical, and functional. A spinning team of a hundred women produce the threads, and a weaving team handloom the fabric used for the shoes. Master artisans, leather cutters, sole crafters, cobblers, and seamstresses, backed up by a production and distribution team, ensure that there is an eclectic range of styles and sizes for sale, in-store. The enterprise was conceived and driven by Bethlehem Tilahun Alemu and employs members of Zenabwork, a marginalized community in the city. Zenabwork is the very community that Bethlehem herself was brought up in. Starting in 2004, she began to create employment opportunities using shoe manufacturing as a platform for hope. All of soleRebel's shoes are a combination of recycled, organic, and bio-based materials, mirroring the traditional Ethiopian selate and barasso shoes. The Adams Pavilion that houses soleRebels is in Saar Bet (next door to Old Airport) on the 2nd floor, above Kaldi's Coffee. Store hours are Monday - Saturday 9:30 am - 7 pm, Sundays by appointment.

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Gastronomy & Hospitality Addis Style

The world's next big super grain - Ethiopia's second gift to the world.

Teff, an Ethiopian staple, is rich in calcium, iron, amino acids, and protein and is naturally gluten free. The global demand for Ethiopia's 'super grain' is growing. Such is its allure that some in the United States are prepared to pay a price of \$12 a bag for teff flour! The tiny teff seeds, ground into a fine flour, can be substituted for wheat flour making an excellent gluten free alternative in baked foods. The flavor is pleasant and nutty, it is a versatile culinary staple, and has good nutritional properties. For all these reasons, the humble grain has attracted wide global attention.

Teff is indigenous to Ethiopia. It is estimated that over six million Ethiopian farmers cultivate the grain and that the crop covers more than twenty percent of all land under cultivation. It is called by some, Ethiopia's second gift to the world after coffee. Different income strata eat different kinds of teff – urban affluent society tend to eat the most expensive white teff, while the less well off, eat red and mixed teff. For the poorest, teff is mixed with other grains, sorghum, and maize, due to rising domestic prices over the past decade, putting the grain out of reach for the very poor.

The raw teff grain is not currently permitted to be traded out of Ethiopia and so to supply increasing demand in Europe and the USA, some American and European farmers have begun cultivating the grain. Suppliers of teff grown in other countries however, would prefer to import the grain directly from Ethiopia.

The Ethiopian government is working to increase teff production as the grain is currently nourishing scholars and students at schools and universities across the country. The introduction of injera in school and university meal programmes plays a big role in helping to reduce malnutrition.

As western consumers acquire a taste for teff, how to ensure that Ethiopia and its farmers benefit, is critical. There is cautious optimism that increased teff production in Ethiopia can truly benefit farmers and address malnutrition, but there is also concern that increased production could benefit business interests at the expense of small farmers, unless careful and monitored planning is undertaken. The United Nation's Food and Agriculture Organization warns that while there is money to be made in new global markets, there must be equally support for small-scale producers so that they can reap the reward from their lucrative crop.

There are Ethiopian specialties cooked to perfection served with delicious injera such as doro wot, bozen shiro, tibs, and kitfo. The menu is varied and offers something for all palates. An excellent way of experiencing Ethiopia's rich selection of dishes all at once is to choose the 'beyanatu', a combination of vegetable dishes on one platter, with injera. The Baata compound also has secondary buildings for more intimate or private gatherings such as the Gojo (a traditionally styled hut). The eatery is an unexpected find in the heart of the city. There is plenty of parking and it is a destination to consider, in its sumptuous setting, away from the busy bustling city.

Sichuan Restaurant Kazanchise

For an entirely different culinary experience, the Sichuan Restaurant in the Odaa Building, opposite the Zemen Bank, Kazanchis is one of Addis' best secrets. A first of its kind, the Sichuan is an eatery conceived by Chef Nebiyu Ermias who became entranced by the Sichuan style of Chinese cuisine soon after he started working, 20 years ago, in the kitchen of the China Bar and Restaurant. Chef Nebiyu worked his way up from humble beginnings to chef apprentice and sous chef in some of Addis' leading restaurants. Seven years ago, he opened his own establishment, which has the distinction of being the only Sichuan kitchen run by an Ethiopian chef assisted by fellow Ethiopians, in the country. What makes Chef Nebiyu's restaurant authentically Chinese are his delicious, freshly prepared dishes – sizzling steak, tangy sweet and sour pork, hot and sour soup, homemade egg noodles, jasmine tea, steamed and fried dumplings, and more. The restaurant interior, furnishings and décor are authentically Chinese. Such is Chef Nebiyu's passion for Sichuan cuisine, that he has travelled twice to China to take master classes in Chinese food preparation. In his own words: Cooking is my passion, I want the guests to feel the texture and the freshness of the food! Chef Nebiyu is onto something: The arrival of China in Ethiopia opens a culinary horizon for the country. One day perhaps, stir fry, steamed food and chopsticks may be as permanently lodged in the Ethiopian imagination as curry, chapattis and chutneys are in the British. In years to come, the traveler may find a Sichuan and other Chinese eateries in Harar, Hawassa, Dessie and Mekelle...the sky is the limit!

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ORNAMENTATION

Ethiopia's ancient heritage

Gold has been one of Ethiopia's enduring exports from the time of ancient Egypt through to the Aksumite Empire. The location of the source of gold was always a well-kept secret, and a secret it will remain. Archaeological sites suggest there was gold smelted in Adulis, the ancient Aksumite port on the Red Sea, where both gilt currency and luxurious items were produced and have been discovered. These items would have been important trade commodities bound for ancient Rome and Arabia. Within Ethiopia, gold would have been reserved for royalty, and in time, the church. Crowns to anoint kings were created by court goldsmiths, following the adoption of Christianity in Ethiopia, facilitated by the clergy. It becomes clear thus, that items forged in gold may well contain a traditional liturgical theme, such as the tsirur (earrings), dinble (pendant) and the ball shaped yegabetcha qelebet (wedding ring), traditionally worn by women of the Tigray. In these items, there is an echo of crowns past, of battles fought, of the sun worshipped by pre-Christian Ethiopians, of a church cupola perched on a highland mountain.

These beautiful ornaments, when worn altogether (including a fourth piece for the forehead), the wedding ring on a silk mateb around the neck are striking. It is common for rings, too small for fingers, to be strung around the neck, together with pendants. The ensemble enhances the wearing of a traditional cotton yebahel qemis (dress) and shama (shawl) worn during religious festivals, wedding ceremonies, public holidays, and other social occasions. In all respects, the ornamentation and clothing unmistakably promotes the grace and dignity of the quintessential Ethiopian woman.

While traditionally, Christian Orthodox Ethiopia crafted gold ornament for kings and church dignitaries, in Moslem Ethiopia, gold was far more current amongst the people of all strata. Ancient and enduring trade routes exposed the east of the country to the worlds of India, Arabia, and all the lands in-between. And filigree work, although perhaps aimed at the Ethiopian Orthodox community, would have employed the techniques and skills of Moslem, Greek, and Armenian, artisans – an addition to Ethiopian creative endeavor from the late 18th century.



Silversmiths have been creating beautiful ornamentation and objects for millennia in the Horn of Africa. The great empire of Aksum, predating the common era, forged silver into jewelry, pots, and other decorative objects. During the height of the Aksumite empire (2nd century CE onwards), three types of coins were minted: gold coins for international markets engraved in Greek, silver coins for (mainly) regional and local markets, and bronze coins that circulated locally. After the decline of the civilization, coins disappeared for centuries, and it was finally in the 19th century that silver and silver jewelry came to be widely traded in Northeast Africa. The metal was derived from coins, coming to the region along the trade routes linking the Arabian Peninsula and the Red Sea, to current day Ethiopia, and for a considerable time, served as currency in the region, particularly during the 1800s. The coins first appeared in the mid-18th century in the Austro-Hungarian Empire. In Ethiopia, they were known as 'siet bir' or 'women's silver'. They were either roughly beaten into pendants – thinner versions of themselves, and by means of a loop soldered onto the sphere, strung around the neck, or they were placed in a crucible and melted down to be turned into a myriad of shapes for ornamentation.

The most common method of creating silver jewelry was the lost wax method. A replica of the item to be produced would be carved out of wax, covered in clay and baked in the sun. When the clay was hard baked, it would be fired, the wax would melt and silver would be poured into the mold.

With Ethiopia's rich cultural history as a background, we invite you to explore modern day city jewelers some, whose works are echoes of times past, others, who have explored new creative and artistic pathways. The beautiful items on sale at the proposed jewelry establishments, are of Ethiopia, made by Ethiopians.

Two well-established and locally famous jewelry stores are to be found in Arada-Piassa - Parseghian Jewelry next to the former British Council building in Adwa Avenue and Tekla Destu in Haile Selassie Avenue.

Kazanchise

Fendika, a traditional Azmari Bet (house) is run by national and internationally renowned traditional dancer Melaku Belay. Performances tend to start later in the evening. Fendika is in Kazanchis where one will find Melaku himself performing with a visiting international artist who just happens to have dropped in of an evening, backed up by his cultural group, EthioColor. The group is an ensemble of some of the finest traditional musicians from Addis Ababa who give captivating and creative performances, bringing to life the rich musical heritage of the country. In his childhood, Melaku eked out a living from the street. It was because of his love of the uniquely Ethiopian 'eskista' dance that he started to work at Fendika for tips. Over many years he made a name for himself as an Azmari performer, dancing, singing, and mastering traditional instruments, becoming professional and in time, the owner of the club. Today he is one of the most important cultural operators and patrons, in Addis Ababa and Ethiopia.

African Jazz Village

Ghion Hotel
